Note

L8a and L8b are the only 5d Swordfish stamps with vertical mesh paper. The official records describe the paper as "rag paper", a description used only for one other value (the 9d, L11a). Stamps L8b can be distinguished from L8a by their having a clear perforation "13 ½" for the whole length of the top and bottom of each stamp.
